

2017 – HYDRANT FLUSHING

Groton Utilities annual water main flushing and testing program continues into the week of June 19th – June 23rd. The program is scheduled to be completed on June 28th, weather permitting.

All Groton Utilities customers should expect intermittent intervals of water discoloration during the June water main flushing process.

Groton Utilities will clean water mains according to the following schedule. Hours of flushing are 8:00am – 4:00pm, Monday through Friday.

Hydrant flushing schedule for June 19th – June 23rd

- Route 12 - Gales Ferry Area to Preston Line
- Long Cove Road
- Avery Hill
- Aljen Heights
- Route 117 to Ledyard Center
- Colonel Ledyard Highway
- Gallup Hill
- Ledyard Highlands
- Shewville Road

At various times during the cleaning, the water will be discolored due to the disturbance of naturally occurring minerals that have settled in the water mains.

The water is safe to drink. However, because of discoloration, Groton Utilities advises customers to store tap water in the refrigerator for drinking and cooking until the water clears up. Residents should also check the condition of the water prior to washing clothes, and, if it is discolored, delay doing laundry until the water is clear.
