Terms and Conditions

APPLICATION OFFER:

Details of this Initiative, including Rebate levels, are considered promotional and are subject to change or cancellation without prior notice. Completed applications must be submitted within 30 days of the equipment installation to be eligible for Rebates.

EQUIPMENT MINIMUM SPECIFICATIONS:

- AHRI Rated Central Air Conditioning Split System (non-ducted) Cooling Only
 - **16 SEER / 13 EER or 15.2 SEER2 / 12.5 EER2**
- AHRI Rated Central Air Conditioning Split Systems (ducted) Cooling Only
 - **16 SEER / 12 EER or 15.2 SEER2 / 11.5 EER2**
- AHRI Rated Mini Split Heat Pump Systems - Single or Multiple Indoor Unit (non-ducted) Cooling and Heat
 - **18 SEER / 13 EER / 9 HSPF or 17 SEER2 / 12.5 EER2 / 8.1 HSPF2**
- AHRI Rated Mini Split Heat Pump Systems - Single or Multiple Indoor Unit (ducted) Cooling and Heat
 - **16 SEER / 12 EER / 8 HSPF or 15.2 SEER2 / 11.5 EER2 / 7.2 HSPF2**

PROOF OF PURCHASE:

An invoice itemizing the purchased equipment must accompany each Rebate application. The invoice copy must indicate the equipment type, size, make and model, serial number of the system and date of purchase. Equipment costs may be validated against industry averages.

APPLICATION FORM:

This application must be filled out completely, truthfully and accurately. An authorized representative of the customer must submit the application along with all documents specified under the *Program Progress* section the application webpage.

PAYMENT:

Please allow six to eight weeks for payment. Payment process may take longer if information is missing on application.

APPROVAL AND VERIFICATION:

Pre-approval from Groton Utilities/Bozrah Light & Power will be required if the Rebate total is **greater than \$8,000** and not to exceed **\$3,000 a ton**. Groton Utilities/Bozrah Light & Power reserves the right to verify sales transactions and to have reasonable access to your facility, to inspect the HVAC system installed under this initiative, prior to issuing Rebates, or at a later time.
