NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

Notice is hereby given that the City of Groton Utilities Commissioners will hold a public hearing on Monday, June 15, 2020 at 6:30 P.M. prevailing time on proposed revisions to the existing water rate schedule. Pursuant to State of Connecticut Executive Order No. 7B "Protection of Public Health and Safety During Covid-19 Pandemic and Response – Further Suspension or Modification of Statutes", dated March 14, 2020, suspending in-person open meeting requirements, all public meetings will be closed to the public at this time. Public Meetings will be televised in real time on Groton Municipal Television Channel 2 and online. Water Rate Increase questions and comments may be submitted to directorsoffice@grotonutilities.com before noon on June 15, 2020. Please include your name and property address on all emails. At this hearing, all consumers of water, property owners serviced by the Water Division, City of Groton, Department of Utilities, and other interested persons written communications relative to the above will be read and considered.

3. TERM OF SERVICE: Water Service is billed on an annual basis. Seasonal Service requires payment of Twelve (12) Monthly Service Charges plus any Consumption Charge incurred.

4. SPECIAL PROVISION: Resale of Water Service is permitted under this Rate Schedule where reseller agrees that all resale consumption over 10,000 CF shall be billed at \$0.034875 per CF per month on and after October 1, 2020, at \$0.036618 per CF per month on and after October 1, 2021, and \$0.038449 per CF per month on and after October 1, 2022 annually in consideration of the extreme seasonal peak demand and lesser annual load factor of Resale Service.
